We treated an 88 year old patient with Pneumonia, successfully for 25 days in our ICU & sent him to Kasturba Hospital a couple of day's back, immediately after he was detected to be COVID-19 positive. He is still alive there. This is a tribute to the excellent treatment that we impart at our hospital, which contrasts with the reports coming from the best hospitals in the Western world where such a patient probably would not have survived this illness.

Meanwhile in line with Govt. regulations, a lockdown was imposed immediately on all new admissions.

We also tested all the other patients in ICU & all our staff (in direct or indirect contact) and all have tested negative.

We are still treating all our existing in-patients in our ICU & elsewhere in our hospital.
